The Carmen B. Pingree Autism Center of Learning is a nonprofit organization with one goal in mind: To help families get real help, the kind of help that ensures tangible results.



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

We are passionate about providing innovative and scientifically proven Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA) treatments for children with autism. And, typically, these treatments lead to better long-term outcomes for individuals.

Early intervention is critical for children with Autism. A critical time to treat those diagnosed with autism is between the ages of 3-6 years old. However, the Pingree Center has approximately 200 children on the waiting list to access our services. So, since we can only serve a limited number of students full time, we've created a new, at-home treatment opportunity for families in Salt Lake, Davis, Summit, Tooele, and Utah counties who are waiting for help.

This in-home program allows us to provide more immediate support, at an affordable price, during a critical window of time in a child's life.



CUSTOM-CREATED PROGRAMS

The Pingree Center is the first in Utah to offer two at-home programs for children of all ages with autism. Each program is created after first becoming acquainted and familiarized with the child. A customized curriculum is then prepared around their specific needs, depending on their individualized assessment.

With each program, the Center provides:

- A consultation and parent training model for families.
- Orientation and parent training about the curriculum and how to work effectively with their child.
- An initial staff assessment to determine the most beneficial programs for each child.
- Accessible consultation and trained staff support either in your home or through telehealth, based on the child's needs.

Both of these community-based programs provide a way for families to receive affordable support as evidence-based ABA interventions occur.

RETHINK Rethink, the web-based curriculum, offers guided instruction in specific behaviorally-based teaching strategies for each and every child. The program provides 7-10 minute training modules of the research-based techniques used in our expert-reviewed, video-based lesson curriculum in an easy to understand language.

With a library of over 1,500 video-based exercises, lesson plans, thousands of learning materials, and an activity center, Rethink offers a comprehensive curriculum that addresses the needs of ASD students with four main focuses: core developmental skills, inclusive practices, transition planning and behavior. Rethink automatically inputs and tracks data of each student's outcomes with easy-to-read tables, graphs and data collection of the student's progress.

COUGHDROP CoughDrop is a program for those who are non-verbal or have limited language. It empowers your child to make their voice heard, using Augmentative and Alternative Communication (AAC) tools. AAC tools help us teach you and your child how to pick the right words and symbols for your child's personal needs. We provide well-researched templates that will get you started and supplement them with proven training resources.

CoughDrop logs all communications and provides insightful reports based on time, location and vocabulary.
